Member states

Since its foundation in 1945, the UN is currently comprised of 193 member states including countries from all over the world, (https://www.un.org/en/about-us/member-states)



The main bodies of the UN

The main bodies of the United Nations are:

- the General Assembly,
- the Security Council,
- the Economic and Social Council,
- the Trusteeship Council,
- the International Court of Justice,
- and the UN Secretariat.

All were established under the UN Charter when the Organization was founded in 1945.



Goals and purposes

While their work is multi-faceted, the UN's goals can be summarized into the following:

- 1. Maintain International Peace and Security.
- 2. Protect Human Rights.
- 3. Deliver Humanitarian Aid.
- 4. Support Sustainable Development and Climate Action.
